

The Carmel Foundation Adopt-A-Senior Holiday Program A compassionate, community-building initiative to brighten the season for low-income older adults.

1. Program Purpose

To ensure that every low-income senior in The Carmel Foundation community – especially the 49 affordable housing residents – feels seen, valued, and supported during the holiday season. Many live on less than \$2,000 per month, making even basic holiday traditions financially out of reach.

This program allows community members to "adopt" a senior by providing practical, meaningful holiday support.

2. How It Works

- a. The Carmel Foundation publishes a curated list of recommended gift items.
- b. Donors select one or more items to contribute.
- c. Items may be dropped off at The Carmel Foundation during operating hours or purchased through a curated Amazon registry.
- d. Staff and volunteers assemble Holiday Care Packages for each senior.
- e. Packages are delivered to housing tenants and others in need before the holidays.

3. Why an Adopt-A-Senior Program Matters

Holiday giving often goes to communities where need is visible. In Carmel-by-the-Sea and the greater Monterey Peninsula, and particularly in the older adult community, the need is often invisible – hidden behind charming cottages and ocean views. Many older adults quietly skip meals, keep their homes cold, or go without basic necessities simply because they cannot afford them.

The Adopt-A-Senior Program gives our broader community a chance to say: "We see you. We remember everything you've given to this place. And you matter."
